- 1. Candidates must be a citizen of India.
- 2. Candidates should posses a Bachelors Degree from a recognized University, Certificate of Shorthand and Typing with speed of 60 w.p.m and 35 w.p.m respectively and proficiency in basic Computer Application.
- 3. **Age limit**: Minimum 18 Years

 Maximum 30 years as on **07.12.2016.**
- 4. In case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribes and Scheduled Castes maximum age relaxation is upto five years, for Most Backward Classes four years and for Other Backward Classes three years.
- 5. Candidates fulfilling the above conditions may apply for the post along with supporting documents duly attested and three recent passport size photographs, addressed to the District and Sessions Judge, South Sikkim at Namchi.
- 6. Applications received without supporting documents and photographs will be summarily rejected.

- 7. The last date for the receipt of application is **07.12.2016**.
- 8. Applications received after the last date i.e., **07.12.2016** shall not be entertained on any ground.
- 9. Those who are already in Government Service shall apply through proper channel.
- 10. The Registry of the District and Sessions Court, South reserves the right to accept or reject any application, with or without any reasons.
